Our primary class is a Spanish immersion program for children 3.0 to 5.9. Here at Rainbow Montessori of Marin, we provide an environment that allows the child to interact with a many aspects of the world as possible. The young child is given an opportunity to develop independently at his or her own pace while still gaining those social, physical, intellectual and emotional skills needed to function at best in society. The curriculum is composed of didactic materials developed by Maria Montessori with additional supplemental materials in language components, music and art. The materials often contain within them a control of error so the child can self-correct without adult intervention. The children learn through doing, experiencing the joy of individual discovery and mastery on their own terms, at their own speed. Education is developing an awareness of the interrelatedness of all life humanities and responsibilities toward it. Children also participating in a peace education program, learning to listen actively, communicate positively, and create compromise and solutions.
